

Example: Convert 34,000 seconds to hours, minutes, and seconds.

60 seconds = 1 minute

$$34,000 \text{ seconds} = \frac{34,000 \text{ seconds}}{60 \text{ seconds}}$$

$$= 566 \text{ minutes } 40 \text{ seconds}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} \text{566 - minutes} \\ 60 \overline{) 34000} \\ \underline{300} \\ 400 \\ \underline{360} \\ 400 \\ \underline{360} \\ 40 \text{ - seconds} \end{array}$$

60 minutes = 1 hour

$$566 \text{ minutes} = \frac{566 \text{ minutes}}{60 \text{ minutes}}$$

$$= 9 \text{ hours } 26 \text{ minutes}$$
